PAT TOOMEY'S DANGEROUS RECORD

Voted against expanding Social Security.

Voted NO on an Amendment proposed by Senator Elizabeth Warren and supported by 42 Senators "To establish a deficit-neutral reserve fund relating to expanding Social Security."

(Amendment 1094, S.Con.Res. 11, the Senate Budget Resolution, March 27, 2015)

Voted against guaranteeing all married couples, regardless of domicile, equal access to Social Security benefits.

Voted to prevent the Social Security Administration from having a confirmed Commissioner.

Voted against protecting current workers—even those within a month of retirement—from benefit cuts, including raising the retirement age.

Voted NO on Senator Wyden's amendment "To create a point of order against legislation that would cut benefits, raise the retirement age, or privatize social security" (despite having voted elsewhere to protect those currently receiving benefits).
